We are honored to host the 2013 SUN meeting in Spain from June 16 to June 21. The core meeting will be in Malaga (Marbella, Costa del Sol) from June 16 (cocktail reception) to June 19. For those who want to visit the magic and monumental city of Granada we have prepared an official extension of the meeting moving to Granada on June 19 and leaving back home on June 21.

Dear friends:

Registration for the 2013 SUN ANNUAL MEETING is now open. We will guide you through the relevant information of all activities. The core meeting will be held in Marbella (Malaga) on June 16-19. There is an optional and no less exciting extension tour to Granada (June 19-20).

We will be delighted to have you in Spain!

REGISTRATION

The registration fee for the 2013 official SUN Meeting will be **1.100 euros**. It covers the participant and accompanying persons. The registration includes attendance to scientific sessions, cultural activities and tours, opening reception, all meals (including gala dinner). For those who want to make the Granada tour (June 19 and 20) registration fee will be **350 euros**, including meals, cultural tours and transportation from Malaga. Early registration deadline (Malaga and Granada meeting) will be **April 15.** Every registration will increase **100 euros** after April 15.

TRIP PLANNING / TRANSPORTATION

Malaga International Airport (Pablo Picasso Airport) is well connected with many European cities and some US cities. London and Paris are good connections. There is also a high-speed train (AVE), **www.renfe.com**, linking Madrid and Malaga (2h30'). The transfers from Malaga Airport to the venue Hotel in Marbella and back (60 km) are not included. The Congress Secretariat can arrange the service and the cost is **100 euros** per person.

ACCOMMODATION

We have rooms reserved for the meeting at Gran Hotel Melia Don Pepe in Marbella (www.granmelia-don-pepe.com) Rates per room and night are: 264 euros the double for single use room; 280 euros the double room and 358 euros the double room plus an extra bed. The Hotel in Granada is the Alhambra Palace Hotel (www.h-alhambrapalace.es) The rates per room and night are: 138 euros the double for single use room; 155 euros the double room and 202 euros the double room plus an extra bed. Both hotels usually are overbooked in June. We have a limited number of reserved rooms for the meeting, and we do advice to make the reservation at your earliest convenience. Deadline for hotel registration (both hotels) is April 1st.
